


Poole town centre to/from Merley, Poole Darbys Lane Proposals





Widening of shared path and vegetation Introduction of double clearance. yellow lines (subject to a Traffic Regulation Order) and dropped kerbs to Trigon Road improve access to the shared path. Johnston Road Installation of a raised table across the junction Heath Avenue to help lower vehicle speeds. Widening of Popes Road footways and introduction of uncontrolled crossings on all arms of the junction to make it safer and easier for pedestrians to navigate the junction. Introduction of double yellow lines (subject to a Traffic Regulation Order). Darbys Lane Darby's Close Route continues Installation of a raised table and parallel crossing along Darbys Lane on the eastern arm of the Darbys Lane/ Dorchester quiet way with new Road junction to encourage lower vehicle speeds wayfinding signage and provide a separate space for pedestrians and to be installed. cyclists. Installation of a small section of cycle lane on Darbys Lane to make it safer and easier for cyclists to navigate the junction. Dorchester Road Introduction of double yellow lines (subject to a Traffic Regulation The Oakdale Order) to create space Centre for the new cycle lane. Oakdale Community Introduction of double Waverley Crescent Park yellow lines (subject to a Traffic Regulation Order) to ensure visibility for safer crossings. Footway widening to facilitate Nansen Avenue uncontrolled crossings to make it safer and easier for pedestrians to cross the road and slow vehicles speeds.
